And they must be tested first; if they prove blameless, then they can serve as deacons. Wives too, must be worthy of respect not slanderers, selfcontrolled, faithful in everything. Deacons must be husbands of one wife, managing their children and their households completely." Deacon nominations should be submitted no later than Sunday, July 28. Nomination forms can be found on the welcome counter. Please put these forms in the offering plate or give them to Harley.

#### **BUILDING LOAN REFINANCE**

Our church building loan will be refinanced in September. As of June 20, 2024, our remaining balance is \$244,340.74. For those who are able, we ask that you give \$156 above your normal tithes and offerings on Anniversary Sunday (August 18) to the Give \$2 fund in honor of our 156th anniversary as a church family. These donations will go directly to paying on our loan principle and will help reduce our loan balance. Remember, you can give to this fund at anytime by designating your offering for the Give \$2 fund. This can be done by writing it on your check or by using a Give \$2 envelope.

and donated to Vacation Bible School.

There was a total of \$1,095.00 donated to help cover the cost of VBS. Your donations covered 100% of expenses.

There were 38 children and 38 volunteers in attendance with an average of 67 people per night. The children collected a total donation of \$174.81 that will go to missions.
