On **Wednesday evenings** during **February**, I will continue the Bible

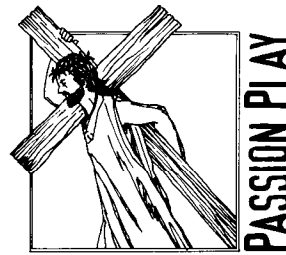
