Please continue to pray for our staff and students.

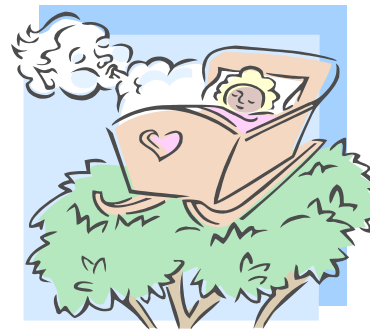
