Our Spanish Fiesta and Graduation programs were fantastic. The children and their families enjoyed themselves very much. We are hoping to make our Fiesta an annual event.

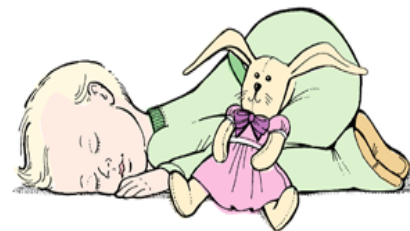
