PASTOR'S NOTES

The **New Year** is a wonderful time to reflect on the past year, and to look to the New Year with anticipation to do better. I encourage you to **set goals** for yourself for 2006, and make it your priority to honor Jesus Christ in your daily life.

On **Sunday, January 1, 2006**, my message will be simply: **"A New Year is Here."** My message will be encouraging to our church family as we begin a New Year together. There will be no Sunday School, nursery, or Children's Church on this Sunday.
