The **Fall Season** is a busy time for the Zion Hill family. It will be a **time of ministry and fellowship** for our entire church family. As we minister to others, and as we fellowship together, let us do it in a way that honors our heavenly Father.

FROM THE DEAN'S DESK

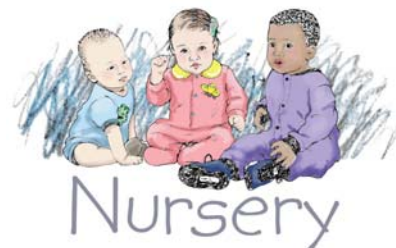
